Tree Planting weekend (Jack):

Amy and Jack and Neil (ARNRG) visited Roborough Rewilding to see how biodiversity has grown since their project started four years ago. Thinking to have more collaboration with Ashreigny. Slightly different geography so will be interesting to see the difference.
